Student accommodation & living expenses

Information on accommodation in Brussels will be sent to nominated students.

Estimated cost of living in Brussels :

- **Accommodation:** 550-750€/month (or more depending on the type of accommodation and services)
- **Food and living expenses:** 350€/month
- **Transportation:** 12€ for a full year (under 24 year old) - or the STIB season ticket (Brussels only)

Grading system

The ECTS **transcripts of records** will be sent to the students by email and to their home university by email and regular mail. This transcript mentions the followed courses, the corresponding ECTS credits, the local grades (20 points) and the ECTS grades. Here, you can find our **grading scale**.

ECTS Grade	Local grade /20	Description
A	17 and more	Excellent performance with only minor errors
B	15-16	Above the average standards, but with some errors
C	13-14	Generally sound work, with a number of notable errors
D	11-12	Fair but with significant shortcomings
E	10	Performance meets the minimum criteria
FX	7, 8, 9	Fail. Some more work required
F	6/20 and less	Fail. Considerable further work required
ABS	-	Absent student

Registration procedure

To be allowed to study at EPHEC, students have to be officially **nominated** by their **home institution**, which must have signed a **student mobility agreement** with EPHEC.

Nominations should be sent by the International Coordinator of our partner institution to **M. Frédéric Simonis** (incoming@ephec.be)

The nomination deadlines are:

- **15 May for the Fall Semester (September - January)**
- **15 November for the Spring Semester (February - June)**
