A CHANCE TO STUDY AND LIVE IN INTERNATIONAL ENVIRONMENT

This year, the BBA Program will grant 1 scholarship for 3rd year student who achieve the GPA of 3.00 or above. Students will be partly financially supported to study at the MONASH University, Melbourne, Australia for one semester and the credits will be transferred back to PSU.

Each student participating in the exchange program shall cover all costs related to:

- 1. Tuition fees at the HOST INSTITUTION
- 2. Travel documents and visas
- 3. Travel to and from the host country
- 4. Living and subsistence expenses as an exchange student
- 5. Accommodation fees and charges by the HOST institution
- 6. Application or related fees as may be charged by the HOST institution
- 7. The cost of health insurance at the HOST INSTITUTION and HOST country and Vaccinations (if required)
- 8.Normal non-tuition course related fees, including but not limited to: Book and academic supplies, study materials costs, field trip and excursion fees etc.
- 9. All other debts, fines or financial penalties incurred during the course of the EXCHANGE

Remarks: The nominated students must also pass the MONASH University selection process to be granted this scholarship
