

## Sharing Shopping Budget Project

Shopping budget / a month: 4,000,000.00 THB (100,000.00 GBP)

To shop: 1,000,000.00 THB (25,000.00 GBP)

To share: 3,000,000.00 THB (75,000.00 GBP)

3 months / a round;

**March 2025** – May 2025

**June 2025** – August 2025

**September 2025** – November 2025

**December 2025** – February 2026

1<sup>st</sup> Round: 15 March 2025

2<sup>nd</sup> Round: 15 June 2025

3<sup>rd</sup> Round: 15 September 2025

**4<sup>th</sup> Round: 15 December 2025**

Budget / A round = 75,000.00 GBP X 3 months  
= 225,000.00 GBP

75.00 GBP X 5,700 People = 427,500.00 GBP / 2 People (Will & Angie)  
= 213,750.00 GBP / 3 Months  
= 71,250.00 GBP / A month  
= 71,250.00 GBP + Budget to print the books of  
Coupons (7,500 GBP / A month)

For: (1) Government officers who work for hospitals, postmen, firemen, garbage managing officers, police officers who are not high-level, and government officers who are not high-level  
(2) Company officers

Note: Divide (1) and (2) to 2 groups = 5,700 People / 2 Groups = 2,850 People, and give the coupons to people who have the worst income of the 2 groups.

How: (1) Ask for British coffee shops in London and Starbucks to join the project.  
(2) Check price of each menu in each British coffee shop where agrees to join the project.  
(3) Print books of coupons\*\*\*\* - Need Budget to print the books of coupons.  
(4) Give the books of coupons to people whom the project is for, near and/or around areas of the coffee shops.  
(5) Coupons can be used with cash.  
(6) If the value of a coupon is less than a receipt, can the coffee shops return a coin to customers?  
(7) Coupons should be used within 3 months.

- Questions:
- (1) How many coffee shops in London where belong to British people?
  - (2) How much does a cup of coffee cost?
  - (3) How much does a loaf of bread cost?
  - (4) How much does a piece of cake cost?

**(5) If I have My application for mobile phones, do every British homeless man and every British person who lives in his car have a mobile phone?**
