BIR Admission

General Qualifications:

- 1. Completion one of the following high school diplomas:
 - Complete GPA minimum of 2.8
 (Mathayom 4-6 / 6 Semesters), or equivalent*
 - GED diploma must obtain at least 165 scores in each subject
 - * Student who is studying/graduated from an International School in Thailand and outside Thailand, please apply with a <u>High School</u> <u>Equivalence Certificate</u> & <u>GPAX Equivalence Certificate</u> issued by HSCES
- 2. Applicants must have one of the following English language proficiency test results (taken within 2 years prior to the application date):
 - TOEFL: a minimum score of 500 on PBT/61 on iBT
 - IELTS: a minimum overall grade of 6.0
 - TU-GET: a minimum score of 500 on PBT / 74 on CBT
 - SAT: a minimum score of 50% on Evidence-Based Reading and Writing

General Criteria:

- 1. Pass an examination which is arranged by BIR Program
- 2. Pass an interview
