Find Student ID

Go to <https://reg.tu.ac.th/> >> Login >> Select menu “**Find Student ID**”
>> Fill in Identification number or name or last name >> Press “**Search**”

Fill in Information

- Login at <https://reg.tu.ac.th/> with your student ID and passport or Identification number
- Fill in your personal information
 - For GCE, GED or IGCSE student, please select “**N/A**” as the country/province and fill in “**0.00**” as the GPA.
 - If your institution is not on the list, please submit the request form. Once the institution has been added, you will be informed via email within two business days.
- Press “**Submit**”

Upload Documents

- Passport
- Transcript and Qualification Certificate (The date of graduation is required)
- Certificate of Name Change (If any)
- Press “**Submit**”

Upload Student Photo

Requirement

- Color photo size: 5x6 cm or 591x709 pixels
- Resolution: 300 dpi
- File Size: 50kb - 1mb
- File Type: JPG
- Lighting: No flash or extremely bright

Apply for Student Card

- Recheck or edit your personal information before press “**Save Student Info**”
- Press “**Submit**” to send request for student card
- Follow the announcement on the Registration.TU Facebook page or at <https://reg.tu.ac.th/> to pick up the student card

Apply for Student Verification

- Download the student verification form and letter of consent
 - Print the student verification form and letter of consent and sign on letter of consent
 - Submit both documents to your previous institution
- * For GCE, GED or IGCSE student submit both documents along with the examination results to your faculty
* The educational background verification process will be completed within one semester, depending on when the verification result is received from the previous institution*

Warning:

- Failure to complete the process or submission of incorrect documents will result in an incomplete registration status.
- New students may request a one-semester deferment of registration at their respective faculty within 14 days of the semester start date.
- Failure to comply with these requirements will result in the revocation of student registration.
